到達目標	<p>The goal of the class is collaboration and independent learning. Students can understand high frequency words and phrases for describing buildings, rooms, places people live and work, education, the internet and technology, language and communication, temperatures, and graphs. Can use some simple structures including comparatives, superlatives, prepositions of time and place, adverbs of frequency, singular and plural nouns, articles, quantifiers and other grammar presented in the course material correctly, but still systematically makes basic mistakes such as mixing up tenses and forgetting to mark agreement.</p>
